## **Exodus: Our Slavery (Exodus 1-2) – September 9-10, 2017**

### **STUDY NOTES || SPEAKING PASTOR TIM HOWEY**

- Till I come, give attention to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine. (1 Timothy 4:13 NKJV)
- Meditate on these things; give yourself entirely to them, that your progress may be evident to all. (1 Timothy 4:15 NKJV)

#### **// THE BOOK OF EXODUS IS A PICTURE OF OUR SPIRITUAL JOURNEY**

- Now these *are* the names of the children of Israel who came to Egypt; each man and his household came with Jacob: (Exodus 1:1 NKJV)
- But the children of Israel were fruitful and increased abundantly, multiplied and grew exceedingly mighty; and the land was filled with them. (Exodus 1:7 NKJV)
- Now there arose a new king over Egypt, who did not know Joseph. (Exodus 1:8 NKJV)
- So the Egyptians made the children of Israel serve with rigor. (Exodus 1:13 NKJV)
- And they made their lives bitter with hard bondage—in mortar, in brick, and in all manner of service in the field. All their service in which they made them serve *was* with rigor. (Exodus 1:14 NKJV)

#### **// ISRAEL'S BONDAGE PICTURES OUR BONDAGE SPIRITUALLY**

- ...you were slaves of sin... Romans 6:17 NKJV
- ...you [were]...slaves of uncleanness... (Romans 6:19 NKJV)
- ...you were slaves of sin... (Romans 6:20 NKJV)
- And a man of the house of Levi went and took as wife a daughter of Levi. (Exodus 2:1 NKJV)
- So the woman conceived and bore a son. And when she saw that he was a beautiful child, she hid him three months. (Exodus 2:2 NKJV)
- And the child grew, and she brought him to Pharaoh's daughter, and he became her son. So she called his name Moses, saying, "Because I drew him out of the water." (Exodus 2:10 NKJV)

- Now it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out to his brethren and looked at their burdens. And he saw an Egyptian beating a Hebrew, one of his brethren. (Exodus 2:11 NKJV)

### **// MOSES' FAILURE PICTURES OUR HOPELESSNESS SPIRITUALLY**

- ...we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh... (Ephesians 2:3 NKJV)

- ...we were dead in trespasses... (Ephesians 2:5 NKJV)

- ...were without Christ... having no hope and without God in the world. (Ephesians 2:12 NKJV)

- Now it happened in the process of time that the king of Egypt died. Then the children of Israel groaned because of the bondage, and they cried out; and their cry came up to God because of the bondage. (Exodus 2:23 NKJV)

- So God heard their groaning, and God remembered His covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob. (Exodus 2:24 NKJV)

- And God looked upon the children of Israel, and God acknowledged them. (Exodus 2:25 NKJV)
