// The book of Exodus is a picture of our spiritual journey

1. Special

- And Moses went up to God, and the Lord called to him from the mountain, saying, “Thus you shall say to the house of Jacob, and tell the children of Israel: Exodus 19:3 NKJV
- ‘You have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and *how* I bore you on eagles’ wings and brought you to Myself. Exodus 19:4 NKJV
- Now therefore, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth *is* Mine. Exodus 19:5 NKJV
- And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.’ These *are* the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel.” Exodus 19:6 NKJV
- So Moses came and called for the elders of the people, and laid before them all these words which the Lord commanded him. Exodus 19:7 NKJV
- Then all the people answered together and said, “All that the Lord has spoken we will do.” So Moses brought back the words of the people to the Lord. Exodus 19:8 NKJV
