// WE HAVE PEACE WITH GOD

- Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; Philippians 4:6 NKJV
- and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:7 NKJV
- Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, Romans 5:1 NKJV
- Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. Romans 5:9 NKJV

// WE WERE ENEMIES OF GOD

- Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God. James 4:4 NKJV
- For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, *that they are* the enemies of the cross of Christ: Philippians 3:18 NKJV
- whose end *is* destruction, whose god *is their* belly, and whose glory *is* in their shame—who set their mind on earthly things. Philippians 3:19 NKJV

// WE WERE RECONCILED TO GOD

- For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. Romans 5:10 NKJV
- And not only *that*, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation. Romans 5:11 NKJV

- through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. Romans 5:2 NKJV
- And not only *that*, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance; Romans 5:3 NKJV
- and perseverance, character; and character, hope. Romans 5:4 NKJV
- Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us. Romans 5:5 NKJV
