// GOD gives us a PERSONAL INVITATION to our journey.

- 'Lech-Lecha' -- 'Go forth' or 'Get going'
- "God doesn't call the QUALIFIED, He QUALIFIES the called."

// God gives us SPECIFIC PROMISES for our journey.
