I Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, *1 Timothy 2:1 NKJV*

for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. *1 Timothy 2:2 NKJV*

For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. *1 Timothy 2:3-4 NKJV*

Is the Holy Spirit turning your world upside down?

But the LORD said to Samuel, "Do not look at his appearance or at his physical stature, because I have refused him. For the LORD does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart." *1 Samuel 16:7 NKJV*

What happened after Saul became king? What does God want us to learn?

So the messengers came to Gibeah of Saul and told the news in the hearing of the people. And all the people lifted up their voices and wept. *1 Samuel 11:4 NKJV*

Now there was Saul, coming behind the herd from the field; and Saul said, "What troubles the people, that they weep?" And they told him the words of the men of Jabesh. *1 Samuel 11:5 NKJV*

Then the Spirit of God came upon Saul when he heard this news, and his anger was greatly aroused. 1 *Samuel 11:6 NKJV*

So he took a yoke of oxen and cut them in pieces, and sent them throughout all the territory of Israel by the hands of messengers, saying, "Whoever does not go out with Saul and Samuel to battle, so it shall be done to his oxen." And the fear of the LORD fell on the people, and they came out with one consent. *1 Samuel 11:7 NKJV*

But Jesus called them to Himself and said to them, "You know that those who are considered rulers over the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great ones exercise authority over them. *Mark 10:42 NKJV*

We will also discover who our true leader is and how we can follow Him before anyone else.

Heart of the Lesson: God's way is always better | 1 Samuel 9-15

Parent Connect: Saul disobeyed God by taking matters into his own hands. Once we do something, we can't take it back, but we can ask forgiveness for what we've done. Practice this by putting shaving cream on your kid's hands and ask them to rub it in. Once it is super foamy, ask them to try and get it off all on their own. It's tough! But once they put their hands under some running water, it all washes away.
