Outward Focus

Help everyone become an <u>outward-focused</u> follower of Jesus

Are you so filled with God that you're living outward-focused?

- Outward
- Upward
- Backward

Being so filled with God that you go to others

But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." **Acts 1:8 NKJV**

Now Saul was consenting to his death. At that time a great persecution arose against the church which was at Jerusalem; and they were all scattered throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria, except the apostles. **Acts 8:1 NKJV**

Now in the church that was at Antioch there were certain prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon who was called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch, and Saul. **Acts 13:1 NKJV**

As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the Holy Spirit said, "Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." **Acts 13:2 NKJV**

Then, having fasted and prayed, and laid hands on them, they sent them away. Acts 13:3 NKJV

Being so filled with God that you look out for others

fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. **Philippians** 2:2 **NKJV**

Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. **Philippians 2:3 NKJV**

Let each of you <u>look out</u> not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. **Philippians 2:4 NKJV**

Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, Philippians 2:5 NKJV

Then one of them, a lawyer, asked Him a question, testing Him, and saying, Matthew 22:35 NKJV

"Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?" Matthew 22:36 NKJV

Jesus said to him, "'You shall <u>love</u> the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' **Matthew 22:37 NKJV**

This is the first and great commandment. Matthew 22:38 NKJV

And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' Matthew 22:39 NKJV

On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets." Matthew 22:40 NKJV

Heart of the Lesson: Gideon | Judges 6-7

Parent Connect: Today we learned about God choosing Gideon to lead the Israelites from under the Midianites. Gideon asked for signs to prove that God had really chose him to win the battle and God showed him two miracles! Play 'Red Light, Green Light' with your kid by holding up something red for Red Light and something green for Green Light. Talk to your kid about the signs God gave Gideon.
