Memory Verse: "Jesus is alive." Matthew 28:6 (adapted for toddlers)

Parent Connect: Today we made little Bible crafts. Help your toddler read the front and inside of the Bible craft. Remind your toddler that the Bible teaches us that "God loves us!" Hang the Bible craft somewhere where you can remind your toddler of this throughout the week.



In this series, we will learn about the greatest Easter story – Jesus dying on the cross for our sins and rising from the grave. The series will cover starting with the Last Supper and continue to His promised return.

Memory Verse: "He is not here; for He is risen as he said." Matthew 28:6a

Heart of the Lesson: Ascension and Promised Return | Luke 24, Acts 1:9-11

Parent Connect: Today the kids learned about Jesus ascending into Heaven and that He promised He will come back. Play a game with your kid by taking soft, light objects and tossing them up. Talk about whether or not they think they will come down slow or fast. Then talk about how Jesus will be coming back down from Heaven someday!



"Descendants" explores our connection to Abraham, revealing how Christians are part of his spiritual family. Through engaging stories and lessons, kids will discover the power of God's promises and learn how He faithfully keeps them. Join us as we journey through faith and uncover our incredible heritage as descendants of Abraham.

Memory Verse: Genesis 26:4 "I will cause your descendants to become as numerous as the stars of the sky, and I will give them all these lands. And through your descendants all the nations of the earth will be blessed."

Heart of the Lesson: God Keeps His Promises | Genesis 11 & 12



We are always looking around us. We can't help it. We see our lives and the lives of our friends and family around us. We know how our parents see us, how our teachers see us and how we see others. We don't often

stop to look at how God sees us, sees our family, see our resources or success. We also don't always view these things in light of eternity. This month we will challenge ourselves to see things the way that God sees them as we keep our Eyes on the Eternal.

Heart of the Lesson: Seeing Yourself as God See You – God sees you as a unique creation (Psalm 139:14-16, Genesis 1:26-27, John 3:16-17)

Parent Connect: As a parent we want to encourage you this week to write an encouraging verse on the mirror in your student's bathroom or mirror in their room. A great verse, is Psalm 139:14 - "Thank you for making me so wonderfully complex! Your workmanship is marvelous—how well I know it." Don't let them forget that they were wonderfully made by their Creator.

Memory Verse: "Think about things that are in heaven. Don't think about things that are only on earth. (Colossians 3:2 NIRV)

Heart of the Lesson: When we see ourselves as God sees, we see His kids (Psalm 139:14-18, Genesis 1:26-27, John 3:16-17, 1 John 4:7-9)

Parent Connect:

- How does it make you feel to remember that God made you on purpose and with purpose?
- What characteristics of God's do you reflect in your own life?
- Do you believe God loves you? Why or why not?
- Who can you tell this week that God sees His kid when He looks at them?
