...God is light... 1 John 1:5 NKJV

I am the light of the world... John 8:12, 9:5 NKJV

Is Jesus your Light?

All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. John 1:3 NKJV

In Him was life, and the life was **the light of men**. John 1:4 NKJV

And **the light** shined in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it. John 1:5 NKJV

There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. John 1:6 NKJV

This man came for a witness, to bear witness of **the Light**, that all through him might believe. John 1:7 NKJV

He was not **that Light**, but was sent to bear witness of **that Light**. John 1:8 NKJV

That was **the true Light** which gives **light** to every man coming into the world. John 1:9 NKJV

He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. John 1:10 NKJV

He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. John 1:11 NKJV

But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: John 1:12 NKJV

Jesus is the Light that God offers to everyone

Jesus is the Light that some people avoid

And this is the condemnation, that **the light** has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than **light**, because their deeds were evil. John 3:19 NKJV

For everyone practicing evil hates **the light** and does not come to **the light**, lest his deeds should be exposed. John 3:20 NKJV

to open their eyes, in order **to turn them** from darkness **to light**, and from the power of Satan **to God**, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me. Acts 26:18 NKJV

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus is God's Gift for Everyone

Parent Connect: Today we learned that Jesus is God's gift for Everyone. As you sit around the dinner table this week, or are driving somewhere as a family, brainstorm with your kids all the people that they know who Jesus is for. Stop and pray for all the people listed and make them a Christ-centered Christmas card!



In this series, we will learn of the great gift God gave to the world, His son Jesus! We will learn how an angel of the Lord visited Mary and Joseph, how they traveled afar to Bethlehem where Jesus was born in a manger, praise the King!

Memory Verse: "And she will have a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for He will save his people from their sins." Matthew 1:21

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus The Savior Is Born | Luke 2

Parent Connect: Today we learned how Mary and Joseph traveled a far distance to Bethlehem and had baby Jesus in a stable! Talk to your kids about holiday travel plans. Look up a map of the destinations that you will be headed, whether in town or out of town! While en route, pretend you are all headed to Bethlehem like Mary and Joseph!



This Christmas season, we are praising the Light of the World as we explore the true meaning of Christmas. We'll discover how Jesus, like a brilliant star, came to bring hope and joy to a dark world, and how his light can shine in each of our hearts. We are going to walk through the Old and New Testaments to reveal the Light of the World and how we can shine our lights today.

Memory Verse: "Jesus spoke to the people once more and said, "I am the light of the world. If you follow me, you won't have to walk in darkness, because you will have the light that leads to life." John 8:12

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus is the Light | John 8, Matthew 2

Parent Connect: Today, we walked through the story of the Magi and how the star in Jesus's birth story represents His guiding light for us today. Go star gazing as a family and talk about the guiding light of Jesus, the Light of the world!

Light

As we wrap up One Vision, we're focusing on the truth that God brings LIGHT into the world. From the very beginning, God promised to send Light into darkness. At Christmas, Jesus came as the Light of the world. And now, because of Him, we get to shine that light to others. As we move through this Christmas season, we want G56 students to understand who God is, who Jesus is, and who they are as children of the Light.

Memory Verse: "The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness can never extinguish it." John 1:5

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus came as the Light of the World – John 1:1-5, 9, 14, John 8:12

Parent Connect: Go on a quick drive or walk to look at Christmas lights. While you're on your walk or drive, ask each other: "What's something true about Jesus that you want to remember this Christmas?" (Example answers: He keeps His promises, He doesn't change, He's with me, He forgives, etc.)
