



Jesus as a Baby (Luke 2:21-39) – Jesus' Life Before Ministry #1

And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men. Luke 2:52 NKJV

Jesus became human so we can know God

And when eight days were completed for the circumcision of the Child, His name was called Jesus, the name given by the angel before He was conceived in the womb. Luke 2:21 NKJV

Now when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were completed, they brought Him to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord Luke 2:22 NKJV

(as it is written in the law of the Lord, “Every male who opens the womb shall be called holy to the Lord”) Luke 2:23 NKJV

and to offer a sacrifice according to what is said in the law of the Lord, “A pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons.” Luke 2:24 NKJV

‘And if she is not able to bring a lamb, then she may bring two turtledoves or two young pigeons—one as a burnt offering and the other as a sin offering. So the priest shall make atonement for her, and she will be clean.’ Leviticus 12:8 NKJV

People who know God recognize Jesus

And behold, there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon, and this man was just and devout, waiting for the Consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him. Luke 2:25 NKJV

And it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ. Luke 2:26 NKJV

So he came by the Spirit into the temple. And when the parents brought in the Child Jesus, to do for Him according to the custom of the law, Luke 2:27 NKJV

he took Him up in his arms and blessed God and said: Luke 2:28 NKJV

"Lord, now You are letting Your servant depart in peace, According to Your word; Luke 2:29 NKJV

For my eyes have seen Your salvation Luke 2:30 NKJV

Which You have prepared before the face of all peoples, Luke 2:31 NKJV

A light to bring revelation to the Gentiles, And the glory of Your people Israel." Luke 2:32 NKJV

Jesus reveals who does & doesn't know God

Then Simeon blessed them, and said to Mary His mother, "Behold, this Child is destined for the fall and rising of many in Israel, and for a sign which will be spoken against Luke 2:34 NKJV

(yes, a sword will pierce through your own soul also), that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed." Luke 2:35 NKJV

He will be as a sanctuary, But a stone of stumbling and a rock of offense To both the houses of Israel, As a trap and a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. Isaiah 8:14 NKJV

And Jesus said, "For judgment I have come into this world, that those who do not see may see, and that those who see may be made blind." John 9:39 NKJV

Parent Connect: This week, help your toddler think of someone they know who is sick. Take the craft out that your toddler made and help them give that to the sick person they thought of. Help your toddler say, "I love you and Jesus loves you too!" to the person who is sick.
