When Abijah died, he was buried in the City of David. Then his son Asa became the next king. There was peace in the land for ten years. **2 Chronicles 14:1 NLT**

Asa did what was pleasing and good in the sight of the Lord his God. 2 Chronicles 14:2 NLT

Asa <u>looked</u> for God with all his heart

Then they entered into a covenant to seek the Lord, the God of their ancestors, with all their heart and soul. **2 Chronicles 15:12 NLT**

All in Judah were happy about this covenant, for they had entered into it with all their heart. They earnestly sought after God, and they found him. And the Lord gave them rest from their enemies on every side. **2 Chronicles 15:15 NLT**

Are you looking for God with all your heart?

Asa was faithful to God with all his heart

Although the pagan shrines were not removed from Israel, Asa's heart remained completely faithful throughout his life. **2 Chronicles 15:17 NLT**

Are you faithful to God with all your heart?

As a stopped <u>trusting</u> God with all his heart

At that time Hanani the seer came to King Asa and told him, "Because you have put your trust in the king of Aram instead of in the Lord your God, you missed your chance to destroy the army of the king of Aram. 2 Chronicles 16:7 NLT

The eyes of the Lord search the whole earth in order to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to him. What a fool you have been! From now on you will be at war." **2 Chronicles 16:9 NLT**
