Jesus talked more about money than heaven + hell + faith combined

For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. Luke 12:34 NKJV

What is money revealing about your heart?

that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death, Philippians 3:10 NKJV

Are you trusting in yourself, or trusting God?

Then He said to His disciples, "Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat; nor about the body, what you will put on. Luke 12:22 NKJV

Life is more than food, and the body *is more* than clothing. Luke 12:23 NKJV

Consider the ravens, for they neither sow nor reap, which have neither storehouse nor barn; and God feeds them. Of how much more value are you than the birds? Luke 12:24 NKJV

And do not seek what you should eat or what you should drink, nor have an anxious mind. Luke 12:29 NKJV

Parent Connect: Remind your toddler of the story of the Good Samaritan. Talk about different people that God sends to care for us (Parents, grandparents, doctors, teachers, etc). Help your kid color a picture to give the helper of their choice. Write "Thank you for caring for me" on the paper. Take your kid to deliver his/her special note

Memory Verse: "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding." -Proverbs 3:5

Heart of the Lesson: Joseph saves his Family | Genesis 41:41 – Genesis 45

Parent Connect: Play a game to explore emotions. Take turns acting out an emotion. Discuss how Joseph felt throughout each of this month's stories.

Parent Connect:

- Read: Luke 12:22–48
- Talk: Jesus said our hearts follow what we treasure. What do you treasure most? Is what you treasure obvious in your life?

- Do: Make a list together of “true treasures” that last.
