Spiritual Hunger is the desire or craving for God.

³⁵And Jesus said to them, “I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst.” ([NKJV John 6:35](#))

God never intended for you to live off of yesterday's spiritual bread.

²Then the whole congregation of the children of Israel complained against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness. ([NKJV Exodus 16:2](#))

³And the children of Israel said to them, “Oh, that we had died by the hand of the LORD in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the pots of meat *and* when we ate bread to the full! For you have brought us out into this wilderness to kill this whole assembly with hunger.” ([NKJV Exodus 16:3](#))

God has fresh spiritual bread for you every day.

⁴Then the LORD said to Moses, “Behold, I will rain bread from heaven for you. And the people shall go out and gather a certain quota every day, that I may test them, whether they will walk in My law or not.” ([NKJV Exodus 16:4](#))

⁵And it shall be on the sixth day that they shall prepare what they bring in, and it shall be twice as much as they gather daily. ([NKJV Exodus 16:5](#))

God gives enough bread for today.

¹⁶This is the thing which the LORD has commanded: ‘Let every man gather it according to each one’s need, one omer for each person, *according to the number of persons*; let every man take for *those who are* in his tent.’ ([NKJV Exodus 16:16](#))

¹⁷Then the children of Israel did so and gathered, some more, some less. ([NKJV Exodus 16:17](#))

¹⁸So when they measured *it* by omers, he who gathered much had nothing left over, and he who gathered little had no lack. Every man had gathered according to each one’s need. ([NKJV Exodus 16:18](#))

¹⁹And Moses said, “Let no one leave any of it till morning.” ([NKJV Exodus 16:19](#))

²⁰Notwithstanding they did not heed Moses. But some of them left part of it until morning, and it bred worms and stank. And Moses was angry with them. ([NKJV Exodus 16:20](#))

²¹So they gathered it every morning, every man according to his need. And when the sun became hot, it melted. ([NKJV Exodus 16:21](#))

³¹And the house of Israel called its name Manna. And it *was* like white coriander seed, and the taste of it *was* like wafers *made* with honey. ([NKJV Exodus 16:31](#))
