## **“Our 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration”**

### **Paul’s 1<sup>ST</sup> Missionary Journey**

- From there they sailed to Antioch, where they had been commended to the grace of God for the work which they had completed. (Acts 14:26 NKJV)
- Now when they had come and gathered the church together, they reported all that God had done with them, and that He had opened the door of faith to the Gentiles. (Acts 14:27 NKJV)

#### **1. // We celebrate what God has done so we don’t get confused**

- For it is God who works in you both to will and to do for *His* good pleasure. (Philippians 2:13 NKJV)

#### **2. // We celebrate what God has done so we don’t grow unthankful**

- So Jesus answered and said, “Were there not ten cleansed? But where *are* the nine? (Luke 17:17 NKJV)
- Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?” (Luke 17:18 NKJV)

#### **3. // We celebrate what God has done so we don’t take God’s credit**

- If anyone speaks, *let him speak* as the oracles of God. If anyone ministers, *let him do it* as with the ability which God supplies... (1 Peter 4:11a NKJV)
