- As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the Holy Spirit said, “Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.” (Acts 13:2 NKJV)
- Then, having fasted and prayed, and laid hands on them, they sent *them* away. (Acts 13:3 NKJV)

Sought, Heard, Confirmed, Went

// Speak Up

- and said, “O full of all deceit and all fraud, *you* son of the devil, *you* enemy of all righteousness, will you not cease perverting the straight ways of the Lord? (Acts 13:10 NKJV)
- Then the proconsul believed, when he saw what had been done, being astonished at the teaching of the Lord. (Acts 13:12 NKJV)

// Keep Trying

- Now when the congregation had broken up, many of the Jews and devout proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas, who, speaking to them, persuaded them to continue in the grace of God. (Acts 13:43 NKJV)
- On the next Sabbath almost the whole city came together to hear the word of God. (Acts 13:44 NKJV)

// God doesn't call us to be successful, He calls us to be faithful

- Now it happened in Iconium that they went together to the synagogue of the Jews, and so spoke that a great multitude both of the Jews and of the Greeks believed. (Acts 14:1 NKJV)
- But the unbelieving Jews stirred up the Gentiles and poisoned their minds against the brethren. (Acts 14:2 NKJV)

- Then Jews from Antioch and Iconium came there; and having persuaded the multitudes, they stoned Paul *and* dragged *him* out of the city, supposing him to be dead. (Acts 14:19 NKJV)
- However, when the disciples gathered around him, he rose up and went into the city. And the next day he departed with Barnabas to Derbe. (Acts 14:20 NKJV)
