Jesus is Counselor

Isaiah 9:6 NKJV - For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Isaiah 9:7 NKJV - Of the increase of His government and peace There will be no end, Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, To order it and establish it with judgment and justice From that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

Psalm 33:10 NKJV - The LORD brings the <u>counsel</u> of the nations to nothing; He makes the plans of the peoples of no effect.

Psalm 33:11 NKJV - The counsel of the Lord stands forever, The plans of His heart to all generations.

Isaiah 28:29 NKJV - This also comes from the Lord of hosts, Who is wonderful in counsel and excellent in guidance.

John 4:13-14 NKJV - Jesus answered and said to her, "Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again, but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life."

John 4:21 NKJV - Jesus said to her, "Woman, believe Me, the hour is coming when you will neither on this mountain, nor in Jerusalem, worship the Father.

John 4:22 NKJV - You worship what you do not know; we know what we worship, for salvation is of the Jews.

John 4:23 NKJV - But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him.

John 4:24 NKJV - God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

John 4:25 NKJV - The woman said to Him, "I know that Messiah is coming" (who is called Christ). "When He comes, He will tell us all things."

John 4:26 NKJV - Jesus said to her, "I who speak to you am He."
