But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, the hidden *wisdom* which God ordained before the ages for our glory, **1 Corinthians 2:7 NKJV**

the mystery which has been hidden from ages and from generations, but now has been revealed to His saints. **Colossians 1:26 NKJV**

In the Bible, a "mystery" is God's Truth that was hidden & is revealed in Scripture

Then He said to them, "O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken! Luke 24:25 NKJV

Ought not the Christ to have suffered these things and to enter into His glory?" Luke 24:26 NKJV

And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself. Luke 24:27 NKJV

Memory Verse: "Jesus was born." Luke 2:6 (adapted for toddlers)

Heart of the Lesson: The Shepherds Came To Visit

Parent Connect: Pull out your family nativity or a kid's nativity and look at the shepherds and sheep together. Ask, "What did the angel tell the shepherds?" (Baby Jesus was born.) "What did the shepherds do?" (They went to visit Him.)



This series will go through the birth of Jesus, starting with an angel bringing good news to Mary and Joseph. Then, wrapping up with Jesus being dedicated at the temple. What a wonderful series to celebrate our Savior, Jesus Christ!

Memory Verse: "And she will have a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for He will save his people from their sins." Matthew 1:21

Heart of the Lesson: An Angel Appears | Luke 1, Matthew 1

Parent Connect: Today we learned about how an angel appeared to Mary to tell her the good news...that she will have a baby named Jesus who will be the savior of the world! Use the craft from today, a song book, and sing songs together celebrating the good news of Jesus!
