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This month we are learning that Jesus is alive, and that He loves us! We are learning the Easter story and how Jesus raised from the dead for us!

Memory Verse: “Jesus is Alive” Mark 16:6B (Adapted for Toddlers)

Heart of the Lesson: We Can Tell Others That Jesus is Alive

Parent Connect: Take a moment today to review with your toddler what we have been learning this month. Use today’s coloring sheet to review with your toddler. We wrote the story out on the back of the sheet if you prefer to read it to your toddler. Help your toddler say, “Jesus is Alive.”



In this series we will learn about Jesus teachings, His miracles, His death and resurrection. We will wrap up with Jesus’ ascension as He goes to Heaven. Through the series, we will learn each story shows us how Jesus loves us and how Jesus is the perfect example of how we should love others!

Memory Verse: “For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life.” John 3:16 (NLT)

Heart of the Lesson: Palm Sunday | Matthew 27-28, Mark 15-16, Luke 23-24

Parent Connect: Today we learned about the day called Palm Sunday when Jesus rode to the temple on a donkey over palm leaves that were laid before Him. Pretend with your kid that you are one of Jesus’ followers and use either a real or fake leaf to lay it on the ground saying “Blessings on the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven, and glory in highest heaven!”



G.R.O.W. fosters spiritual growth, like plants nurtured in fertile soil. This series explores what happens when we spend time with God: Growth, Rest, Outreach, and Worship.

Memory Verse: But the godly will flourish like palm trees and grow strong like cedars of Lebanon. For they are transplanted to the LORD’s own house. They flourish in the courts of our God. Even in old age they will still produce fruit; they will remain vital and green. Psalm 92:12-14

Heart of the Lesson: Worshipping God Helps Us Grow in Our Faith - John 12

Parent Connect: As we celebrate Palm Sunday, take some time and go on a walk through nature. Talk about the things that catch your eye and worship God for them. Listen to all the sounds too!

Did you know that there are more than 50 commands of how Christians should treat one another in the New Testament? In this series, we will be exploring the different “one another” passages to discover what it looks like to be in the body of Christ.

Memory Verse: “So now I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other.” John 13:34

Heart of the Lesson: Response Stations - As Christians, we are called to encourage one another – Hebrews 10:19-25

Parent Connect: Ask your student to write a card of encouragement to a friend or family member! Encourage them to hand-deliver the card if possible.

But we need to build friendships with each other to be able to help each other grow closer to Jesus! This series, we’re looking at what the Bible says about how we can love one another well so that we know Jesus better too.
