He is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock. And when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently against that house, and could not shake it, for it was founded on the rock. **Luke 6:48**

But he who heard and did nothing is like a man who built a house on the earth without a foundation, against which the stream beat vehemently; and immediately it fell. And the ruin of that house was great.” **Luke 6:49**

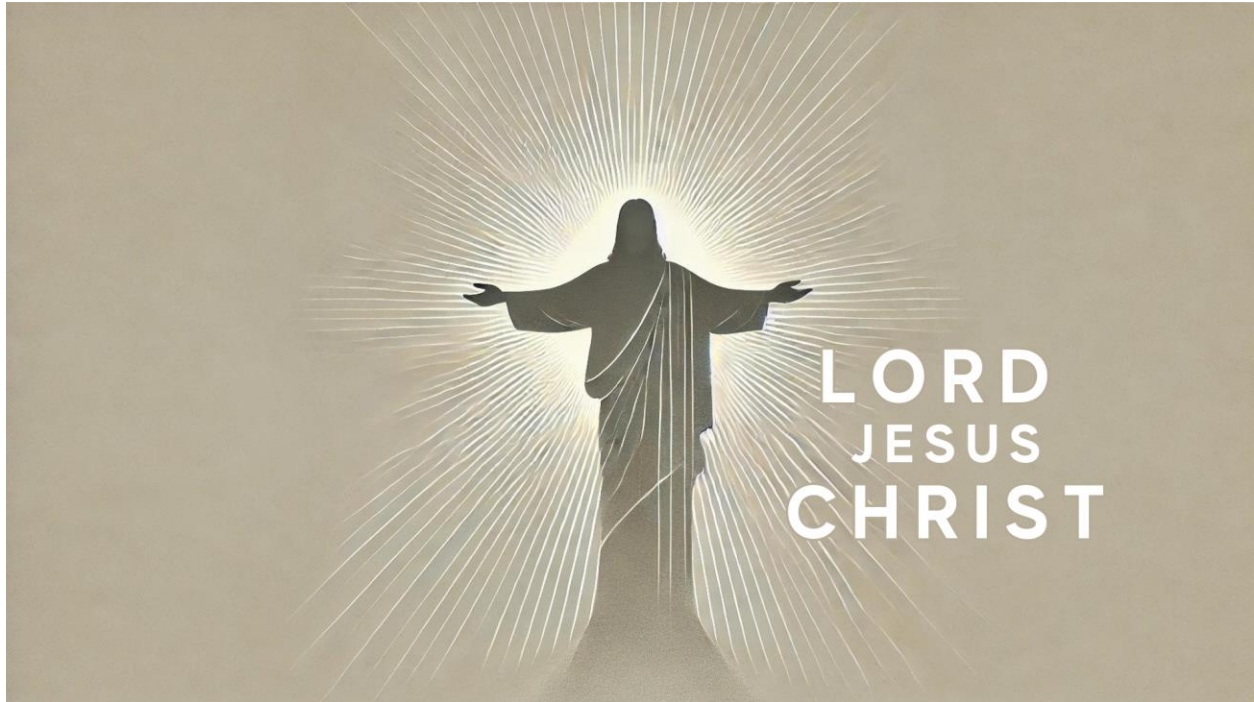

### **Lord Jesus Christ is a name above all names**

Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, **Philippians 2:9 NKJV**

that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, **Philippians 2:10 NKJV**

and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. **Philippians 2:11 NKJV**

### **What does the name Jesus mean?**

These *are* the names of the men whom Moses sent to spy out the land. And Moses called Hoshea the son of Nun, Joshua. **Numbers 13:16 NKJV**

And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins.” **Matthew 1:21 NKJV**

And in that day you will say: "O Lord, I will praise You; Though You were angry with me, Your anger is turned away, and You comfort me. **Isaiah 12:1 NKJV**

Behold, **God is my salvation**, I will trust and not be afraid; 'For **Yah, the Lord**, is my strength and song; He also has become my salvation.' " **Isaiah 12:2 NKJV**

## **What is God the Father's perspective on Jesus?**

### **Jesus is God's only begotten Son**

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. **John 3:16 NKJV**

No one has seen God at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared *Him*. **John 1:18 NKJV**

### **Jesus is God's Beloved Son**

And the Holy Spirit descended in bodily form like a dove upon Him, and a voice came from heaven which said, "You are My beloved Son; in You I am well pleased." **Luke 3:22 NKJV**

## **What does Jesus' name mean to us?**

### **Jesus' name gives us forgiveness**

To Him all the prophets witness that, through His name, whoever believes in Him will receive remission of sins." **Acts 10:43 NKJV**

### **Jesus' name gives us power**

And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. **John 14:13 NKJV**

If you ask anything in My name, I will do *it* **John 14:14 NKJV**

### **Jesus' name gives us purpose**

And whatever you do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him. **Colossians 3:17 NKJV**

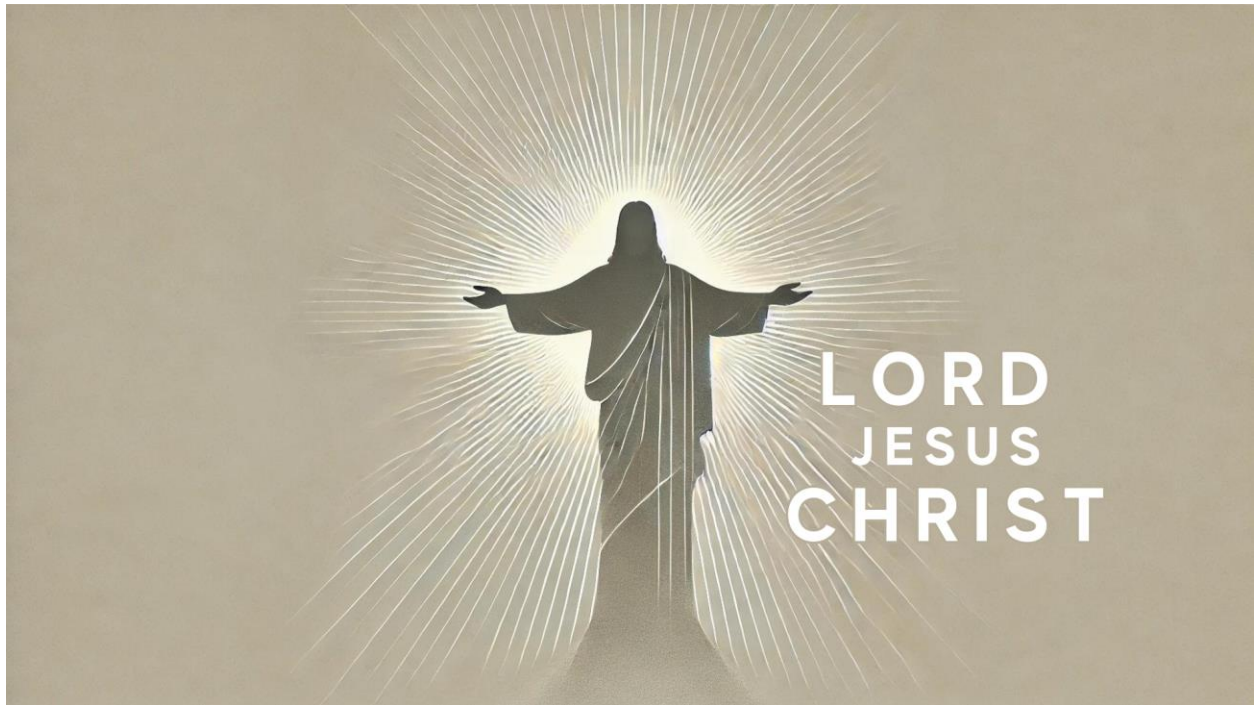

If anyone does not love the Lord Jesus Christ, let him be accursed. O Lord, come!" 1  
**Corinthians 16:22 NKJV**

### **God the Father reveals the Christ**

He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" Simon Peter answered and said, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Jesus answered and said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but My Father who is in heaven.

**Matthew 16:15-17**

### **There are enemies of Christ**

For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, *that they are the* enemies of the cross of Christ: whose end *is* destruction, whose god *is their belly*, and whose glory *is* in their shame—who set their mind on earthly things. **Philippians 3:18-19 NKJV**

"If You are the Christ, tell us." But He said to them, "If I tell you, you will by no means believe.

But Simon Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. Also we have come to believe and know that You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."  
**John 6:68 - 69 NKJV**

### **Jesus is the Christ**

Then the Jews surrounded Him and said to Him, "How long do You keep us in doubt? If You are the Christ, tell us plainly." **John 10:24 NKJV**

Jesus answered them, "I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in My Father's name, they bear witness of Me. **John 10:25 NKJV**

But you do not believe, because you are not of My sheep, as I said to you. **John 10:26 NKJV**

My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. **John 10:27 NKJV**

And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. **John 10:28 NKJV**

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. **Romans 1:16 NKJV**

**Memory Verse:** "Jesus Cares" 1 Peter 5:7 (Adapted for Toddlers)

**Heart of the Lesson:** We can be Happy That Jesus Cares

**Parent Connect:** Sing this song with you toddler to the tune of "Looby Loo"

Give all your cares to God.  
Give God your worries, too.  
Give all your cares to God.  
God cares what happens to you. (Repeat)



In this series we will learn about Israel's first king, Saul and a great king, David. God taught both kings important lessons while they were ruling the Israelites.

**Memory Verse:** "The LORD doesn't see things the way you see them. People judge by outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart." 1 Samuel 16:7b

**Heart of the Lesson:** David the Anointed King | 1 Samuel 15-16

**Parent Connect:** Today we learned about how David became the Israelites new king. God saw that David's heart and how much David loved God. Talk to your kid about things that we love about someone on the outside; smile, hair, laugh! Then talk about things we can love about someone on the inside; kindness, generosity, caring.



**Memory Verse:** "If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved." Romans 10:9

**Heart of the Lesson:** Because Jesus is Lord we can CALL on him to save us. Luke 18:35-43

**Parent Connect:** During the month of October, the adults have studied "Lord Jesus Christ." In GraceKids we have looked at Jesus through the lens of the ABCs. Talk with your kids about what it was like when you: ADMITTED you were a sinner; chose to BELIEVE in Jesus, and CALLED on him to save you. Then pray with your kids for someone else you know that needs to hear the ABCs of salvation.



# Lord Jesus Christ

In this series, we will be seeking to understand what the names “Lord”, “Jesus”, and “Christ” mean and how we should respond. We will go through interactive stations and discussion questions that give students the opportunity to reflect on who Jesus is in their life personally.

**Memory Verse:** “Then the name of our Lord Jesus will be honored because of the way you live, and you will be honored along with him. This is all made possible because of the grace of our God and Lord, Jesus Christ.” 2 Thessalonians 1:12

**Heart of the Lesson:** Who is Christ? Christ is the promised Messiah (John 1:21, John 4:25, Acts 10:38)

**Parent Connect:** Our hope is in Jesus; this is a great opportunity to talk with your student about how Jesus is your hope and that you are thankful that He is the Messiah. Don’t underestimate the influence that you as a parent have when you share your spiritual walk with your student.
