# Have you ever rejected what God told you to do?

# **One Vision: Seeing as God Sees**

You shall go down before me to Gilgal; and surely I will come down to you to offer burnt offerings *and* make sacrifices of peace offerings. Seven days you shall wait, till I come to you and show you what you should do." *1 Samuel 10:8 NKJV* 

# Have you ever rejected what God told you to do?

Then he waited seven days, according to the time set by Samuel. But Samuel did not come to Gilgal; and the people were scattered from him. *1 Samuel 13:8 NKJV* 

So Saul said, "Bring a burnt offering and peace offerings here to me." And he offered the burnt offering. 1 Samuel 13:9 NKJV

Now it happened, as soon as he had finished presenting the burnt offering, that Samuel came; and Saul went out to meet him, that he might greet him. *1 Samuel 13:10 NKJV* 

And Samuel said, "What have you done?" Saul said, "When I saw that the people were scattered from me, and that you did not come within the days appointed, and that the Philistines gathered together at Michmash, 1 Samuel 13:11 NKJV

then I said, 'The Philistines will now come down on me at Gilgal, and I have not made supplication to the Lord.' Therefore I felt compelled, and offered a burnt offering." *1 Samuel 13:12 NKJV* 

# Saul's impatience with God was disobedience

And Samuel said to Saul, "You have done foolishly. You have not kept the commandment of the Lord your God, which He commanded you. For now the Lord would have established your kingdom over Israel forever. *1 Samuel 13:13 NKJV* 

But now your kingdom shall not continue. The Lord has sought for Himself a man after His own heart, and the Lord has commanded him to be commander over His people, because you have not kept what the Lord commanded you." *1 Samuel 13:14 NKJV* 

# 1 Samuel 14 – Saul's Rash Oath

Samuel also said to Saul, "The Lord sent me to anoint you king over His people, over Israel. Now therefore, heed the voice of the words of the Lord. *1 Samuel 15:1 NKJV* 

But Saul and the people spared Agag and the best of the sheep, the oxen, the fatlings, the lambs, and all that was good, and were unwilling to utterly destroy them. But everything despised and worthless, that they utterly destroyed. *1 Samuel 15:9 NKJV* 

# Saul's partial obedience to God was disobedience

Then Samuel went to Saul, and Saul said to him, "Blessed are you of the Lord! I have performed the commandment of the Lord." *1 Samuel 15:13 NKJV* 

But Samuel said, "What then is this bleating of the sheep in my ears, and the lowing of the oxen which I hear?" *1 Samuel 15:14 NKJV* 

And Saul said, "They have brought them from the Amalekites; for the people spared the best of the sheep and the oxen, to sacrifice to the Lord your God; and the rest we have utterly destroyed." *1 Samuel 15:15 NKJV* 

So Samuel said: "Has the Lord as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, As in obeying the voice of the Lord? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, And to heed than the fat of rams. *1 Samuel 15:22 NKJV* 

For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, And stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of the Lord, He also has rejected you from being king." *1 Samuel 15:23 NKJV*

#### Heart of the Lesson: God Always Has a Plan | 1 Samuel 18-20

Parent Connect: David had to wait a long time to become king, demonstrating patience and trust in God's plan. Grab a clear jar or container and brainstorm some things you are currently waiting for (e.g., a special trip). Write each item on a separate slip of paper and put it in the jar. Add a few "challenge" slips to the jar as well (e.g., "Do an extra chore,"). Each day, have a family member draw a slip from the jar, and discuss how they can respond with a good attitude, just like David continued to serve Saul despite the difficulties.
