In this series, we will learn that God made our families and that He cares so much for them! We learn about the story of Abraham and Sarah, and how God gave them a family with their son Isaac.

Memory Verse: "God made families." Genesis 1:26a (adapted for toddlers)

Heart of the Lesson: God Made Families and Families Help Each Other

Parent Connect: Have your whole family work together to help your toddler build a tent out of blankets. Crawl inside and ask your toddler "whose family lived in a tent?" (Abraham and Sarah) Have them wear the beard they made and pretend to be Abraham living in his tent. If you have multiple children encourage them all to play together and remind them that "God made families and families help each other"



In this series, kids will discover that God is mighty- stronger than sickness, armies, fear and even enemies! Through the stories of Elisha's miracles, Jehoshaphat's victory through praise, Naaman's healing, and Hezekiah's trust in God, kids will learn that God helps His people in powerful ways.

Memory Verse: Don't be afraid, for I am with you. Don't be discouraged, for I am your God." Isaiah 41:10a

Heart of the Lesson: Jehoshaphat's Big Victory | 2 Chronicles 20

Parent Connect: This week, practice praying big prayers together. Jehoshaphat prayed big prayers in 2 Chronicles 20, and God answered. Is there something big you and your kid can pray for together this week?



The Kid's Choice series gives our kids an opportunity to choose what we talk about. In this series, we will answer three big questions all about the Bible. Who wrote it? How do we know its true? Why should I read it? All of this and more will get answered.

Memory Verse: "Then Jesus called for the children and said to the disciples, "Let the children come to me. Don't stop them! For the Kingdom of God belongs to those who are like these children." Luke 18:16

Heart of the Lesson: Holy people inspired by God wrote the Bible! | 2 Timothy 3

Parent Connect: Today we learned that the Bible has multiple authors: God and over 40 people. The entire Bible was written down physically by people but inspired by God. Sit behind your kid facing their back. Trace an image on their back with your finger and have them recreate it on a piece of paper in front of them. Talk about how you inspired their drawing, but they are the ones who did it, similarly to the Bible!

GRACE

Grace is God giving us what we don't deserve: kindness, forgiveness, and a place in His family. In this series, we'll learn how to see grace the way that God does. We will explore what grace looks like, how it shows up in the Bible, and how it changes our everyday lives.

Memory Verse: "God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God." Ephesians 2:8

Heart of the Lesson: What is Grace? Grace is undeserved favor from God shown through Jesus. (Romans 6:23, Ephesians 2:1-10)

Parent Connect: Use a simple object lesson with a wrapped gift. Give your student a gift that they didn't earn: something small like a sweet treat. Talk about how God's grace is like that gift: we don't earn it, but He gives it freely because He loves us. Encourage them to think about what God has freely given them through His grace.
