Are people good?

One Vision: Seeing as God Sees

Who was Saul? What does God want us to learn?

Then all the elders of Israel gathered together and came to Samuel at Ramah, **1 Samuel 8:4 NKJV**

and said to him, "Look, you are old, and your sons do not walk in your ways. Now make us a king to judge us like all the nations." **1 Samuel 8:5 NKJV**

But the thing displeased Samuel when they said, "Give us a king to judge us." So Samuel prayed to the LORD. **1 Samuel 8:6 NKJV**

And the LORD said to Samuel, "Heed the voice of the people in all that they say to you; for they have not rejected you, but they have rejected Me, that I should not reign over them. **1 Samuel 8:7 NKJV**

God was good to His people after they rejected Him

Or do you despise the riches of His goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering, not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance? **Romans 2:4 NKJV**

There was a man of Benjamin whose name was Kish the son of Abiel, the son of Zeror, the son of Bechorath, the son of Aphiah, a Benjamite, a mighty man of power. **1 Samuel 9:1 NKJV**

And he had a choice and handsome son whose name was Saul. There was not a more handsome person than he among the children of Israel. From his shoulders upward he was taller than any of the people. **1 Samuel 9:2 NKJV**

Now the LORD had told Samuel in his ear the day before Saul came, saying, **1 Samuel 9:15 NKJV**

"Tomorrow about this time I will send you a man from the land of Benjamin, and you shall anoint him commander over My people Israel, that he may save My people from the hand of the Philistines; for I have looked upon My people, because their cry has come to Me." **1 Samuel 9:16 NKJV**

So when Samuel saw Saul, the LORD said to him, "There he is, the man of whom I spoke to you. This one shall reign over My people." **1 Samuel 9:17 NKJV**

Saul looked good to people but lacked God's character

...man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart." 1 Samuel 16:7 NKJV

Then Samuel took a flask of oil and poured it on his head, and kissed him and said: "Is it not because the LORD has anointed you commander over His inheritance? **1 Samuel 10:1 NKJV**

Then the Spirit of the LORD will come upon you, and you will prophesy with them and be turned into another man. **1 Samuel 10:6 NKJV**

And let it be, when these signs come to you, that you do as the occasion demands; for God is with you. **1 Samuel 10:7 NKJV**

Therefore they inquired of the LORD further, "Has the man come here yet?" And the LORD answered, "There he is, hidden among the equipment." **1 Samuel 10:22 NKJV**

God is good to people after they reject Him

People can look good but lack God's character

God is good despite knowing people will reject Him

Heart of the Lesson: God makes plants grow

Heart of the Lesson: Joshua | Joshua 1-12

Parent Connect: Today we learned that God helped Joshua overcome, even through hard moments like saying Goodbye to Moses. Look up saddleback Kids on YouTube and watch the videos on Joshua and ask your kid to find all the ways that God helped Joshua overcome.



Samuel, Saul, and David were very different leaders, all chosen by God. In this series, we are going to examine what it looks like to follow a leader who is dedicated to God or to follow a leader who is dedicated to getting his own way. We will also discover who our true leader is and how we can follow Him before anyone else.

Memory Verse: For I have kept the ways of the LORD; I have not turned from my God to follow evil. 2 Samuel 22:22

Heart of the Lesson: God is our ultimate leader | 1 Samuel 1-8

Parent Connect: Make your own "tin can telephone" and practice whispering sayings from one end to the other. It sometimes can be tricky to hear someone in a way we've never heard them before, but with practice and help from someone older, we can learn to recognize their voice. We can do the same thing with God!
