David is in a storm

Bend down, O Lord, and hear my prayer; answer me, for I need your help. Psalm 86:1 NLT

Protect me, for I am devoted to you. Save me, for I serve you and trust you. You are my God. **Psalm 86:2a NLT**

After removing Saul, he made David their king. God testified concerning him: 'I have found David son of Jesse, a man after my own heart; he will do everything I want him to do.' **Acts 13:22 NLT**

Save me, for I serve you and trust you. You are my God. Psalm 86:2b NLT

Be merciful to me, O Lord, for I am calling on you constantly. Psalm 86:3 NLT

Give me happiness, O Lord, for I give myself to you. Psalm 86:4 NLT

O Lord, you are so good, so ready to forgive, so full of unfailing love for all who ask for your help. **Psalm 86:5 NLT**

Spiritual growth is shortening the time between trouble and trust

As for God, his way is perfect: The Lord's word is flawless; he shields all who take refuge in him. **2 Samuel 22:31 NLT**

Listen closely to my prayer, O Lord; hear my urgent cry. Psalm 86:6 NLT

I will call to you whenever I'm in trouble, and you will answer me. Psalm 86:7 NLT

Anyone who listens to my teaching and follows it is wise, like a person who builds a house on solid rock. **Matthew 7:24 NLT**

Though the rain comes in torrents and the floodwaters rise and the winds beat against that house, it won't collapse because it is built on bedrock. **Matthew 7:25 NLT**
