God made his people special: The 10 Commandments

We learn about our journey of faith by studying Israel

#### The 10 Commandments reflect God's goodness and perfection

Now therefore, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth *is* Mine. **Exodus 19:5 NKJV** 

And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.' These *are* the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel." **Exodus 19:6 NKJV** 

Then all the people answered together and said, "All that the Lord has spoken we will do." So Moses brought back the words of the people to the Lord. **Exodus 19:8 NKJV** 

Then it came to pass on the third day, in the morning, that there were thunderings and lightnings, and a thick cloud on the mountain; and the sound of the trumpet was very loud, so that all the people who *were* in the camp trembled. **Exodus 19:16 NKJV** 

### Commandment #1-4

(Exodus 20:3-11)

- No other gods
- No carved images
- Not take God's name in vain
- Remember the Sabbath

Commandment #5-10 (Exodus 20:12-17)

- Honor your parents
- No murder
- No adultery
- No stealing
- No false witness
- No coveting

And Moses said to the people, "Do not fear; for God has come to test you, and that His fear may be before you, so that you may not sin." **Exodus 20:20 NKJV** 

#### The 10 commandments show us that we need a Savior

And the commandment, which was to bring life, I found to bring death. Romans 7:10 NKJV

For sin, taking occasion by the commandment, deceived me, and by it killed me. Romans 7:11 NKJV

Therefore the law is holy, and the commandment holy and just and good. Romans 7:12 NKJV

Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith. Galatians 3:24 NKJV

#### Jesus sets us free from the law to love

having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross. **Colossians 2:14 NKJV** 

We love Him because He first loved us. 1 John 4:19 NKJV

Owe no one anything except to love one another, for he who loves another has fulfilled the law. **Romans 13:8 NKJV** 

#### Jesus in us reflects God's goodness and perfection

But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; **1 Peter 2:9 NKJV**

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus is With Us When We're Scared of Being Alone - Jesus Calms the Storm - Mark 4:35-41

**Parent Connect:** Read Mark 4:35-41 to your toddler from a real Bible or a storybook Bible. Look at today's coloring sheet together. What is happening in each picture? Remind your toddler that Jesus is always with us even when we are scared.

Memory Verse: God is our refuge and strength, always ready to help in times of trouble. Psalm 46:1 NLT

Heart of the Lesson: Love God; Love Others. - The Ten Commandments - Exodus 19-20

**Parent Connect:** Using today's spinner craft and the back of the coloring sheet, review each of the 10 commandments with your kid. Which ones do they understand well? Which ones do they need your help understanding better? Discuss the 10 commandments with your kids throughout the week. Can you memorize them together?



In this series we will learn about the Israelites journey as a nation out of Egypt and into the wilderness. We will cover from Moses first being called to lead the Israelites, all the way to Joshua taking over and leading them into the promised land! We can learn about our journey of faith by studying Israel and their journey as a nation.
