Jesus is the Ultimate Servant

Jesus said, servants aren't about being the greatest

- Then they departed from there and passed through Galilee, and He did not want anyone to know it.

 Mark 9:30 NKJV
- For He taught His disciples and said to them, "The Son of Man is being betrayed into the hands of men, and they will kill Him. And after He is killed, He will rise the third day." Mark 9:31 NKJV
- But they did not understand this saying, and were afraid to ask Him. Mark 9:32 NKJV
- Then He came to Capernaum. And when He was in the house He asked them, "What was it you disputed among yourselves on the road?" But they kept silent, for on the road they had disputed among themselves who would be the greatest. Mark 9:33-34 NKJV
- And He sat down, called the twelve, and said to them, "If anyone desires to be first, he shall be last of all and servant of all." Mark 9:35 NKJV
- Then He took a little child and set him in the midst of them. And when He had taken him in His arms, He said to them, "Whoever receives one of these little children in My name receives Me; and whoever receives Me, receives not Me but Him who sent Me." Mark 9:36-37 NKJV

Jesus said, servants aren't about having the most

- Then James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came to Him, saying, "Teacher, we want You to do for us whatever we ask." Mark 10:35 NKJV

- And He said to them, "What do you want Me to do for you?" Mark 10:36 NKJV
- They said to Him, "Grant us that we may sit, one on Your right hand and the other on Your left, in Your glory."

 Mark 10:37 NKJV
- But Jesus said to them, "You do not know what you ask. Are you able to drink the cup that I drink, and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with?" They said to Him, "We are able." Mark 10:38 NKJV
- So Jesus said to them, "You will indeed drink the cup that I drink, and with the baptism I am baptized with you will be baptized; Mark 10:39 NKJV
- but to sit on My right hand and on My left is not Mine to give, but it is for those for whom it is prepared."
 Mark 10:40 NKJV
- And when the ten heard it, they began to be greatly displeased with James and John. Mark 10:41 NKJV
- But Jesus called them to Himself and said to them, "You know that those who are considered rulers over the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great ones exercise authority over them. Mark 10:42 NKJV
- Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you shall be your servant. And whoever of you desires to be first shall be slave of all. Mark 10:43-44 NKJV
- For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."
 Mark 10:45 NKJV

Jesus is the Ultimate Servant

- Following Jesus requires extreme <u>selflessness</u>
- Following Jesus requires extreme pursuit of servanthood
- Following Jesus requires extreme sacrifice
