Samuel: The Battle to See - June 15, 2025

One Vision: Seeing as God Sees

But the LORD said to Samuel, "Do not look at his appearance or at his physical stature, because I have refused him. For the LORD does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart." 1 Samuel 16:7 NKJV

Samuel was faithful to God by His message

Then Samuel spoke to all the house of Israel, saying, "If you return to the LORD with all your hearts, then put away the foreign gods and the Ashtoreths from among you, and prepare your hearts for the LORD, and serve Him only; and He will deliver you from the hand of the Philistines." 1 Samuel 7:3 NKJV

So the children of Israel put away the Baals and the Ashtoreths, and served the LORD only. 1 Samuel 7:4 NKJV

And Samuel said, "Gather all Israel to Mizpah, and I will pray to the Lord for you." 1 Samuel 7:5 NKJV

So they gathered together at Mizpah, drew water, and poured it out before the Lord. And they fasted that day, and said there, "We have sinned against the Lord." And Samuel judged the children of Israel at Mizpah. 1 Samuel 7:6 NKJV

Samuel was faithful to God by His sacrifice

Now when the Philistines heard that the children of Israel had gathered together at Mizpah, the lords of the Philistines went up against Israel. And when the children of Israel heard *of it,* they were afraid of the Philistines. 1 Samuel 7:7 NKJV

So the children of Israel said to Samuel, "Do not cease to cry out to the LORD our God for us, that He may save us from the hand of the Philistines." 1 Samuel 7:8 NKJV

And Samuel took a suckling lamb and offered it as a whole burnt offering to the Lord. Then Samuel cried out to the Lord for Israel, and the Lord answered him. 1 Samuel 7:9 NKJV

Now as Samuel was offering up the burnt offering, the Philistines drew near to battle against Israel. But the Lord thundered with a loud thunder upon the Philistines that day, and so confused them that they were overcome before Israel. 1 Samuel 7:10 NKJV

And the men of Israel went out of Mizpah and pursued the Philistines, and drove them back as far as below Beth Car. 1 Samuel 7:11 NKJV

Samuel was faithful to God by his consistency

Then Samuel took a stone and set it up between Mizpah and Shen, and called its name Ebenezer, saying, "Thus far the Lord has helped us." 1 Samuel 7:12 NKJV

So the Philistines were subdued, and they did not come anymore into the territory of Israel. And the hand of the LORD was against the Philistines all the days of Samuel. 1 Samuel 7:13 NKJV

Then the cities which the Philistines had taken from Israel were restored to Israel, from Ekron to Gath; and Israel recovered its territory from the hands of the Philistines. Also there was peace between Israel and the Amorites. 1 Samuel 7:14 NKJV

And Samuel judged Israel all the days of his life. 1 Samuel 7:15 NKJV

He went from year to year on a circuit to Bethel, Gilgal, and Mizpah, and judged Israel in all those places. 1 Samuel 7:16 NKJV

But he always returned to Ramah, for his home was there. There he judged Israel, and there he built an altar to the Lord. 1 Samuel 7:17 NKJV
