Our Father [Who art] in heaven Hallowed be Your name. Matthew 6:9 NKJV

Our Father... Matthew 6:9 NKJV

God is our Dad – & the best Dad possible

And when you pray, do not use vain repetitions as the heathen do. For they think that they will be heard for their many words. **Matthew 6:7 NKJV**

Therefore do not be like them. For your Father knows the things you have need of before you ask Him. **Matthew 6:8 NKJV**

In this manner, therefore, pray... Matthew 6:9 NKJV

Therefore do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' **Matthew 6:31 NKJV**

For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. **Matthew 6:32 NKJV**

But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. **Matthew 6:33 NKJV**

Or what man is there among you who, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? **Matthew** 7:9 **NKJV**

Or if he asks for a fish, will he give him a serpent? Matthew 7:10 NKJV

If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him! **Matthew 7:11 NKJV**

Our Dad is in heaven - all-seeing, all-knowing, all-powerful

The LORD is in His holy temple, The LORD's throne is in heaven; His eyes behold, His eyelids test the sons of men. **Psalm 11:4 NKJV**

But our God is in heaven; He does whatever He pleases. Psalm 115:3 NKJV

and said: "O LORD God of our fathers, are You not God in heaven, and do You not rule over all the kingdoms of the nations, and in Your hand is there not power and might, so that no one is able to withstand You? **2 Chronicles 20:6 NKJV**

Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our sins, just as we also have forgiven those who sin against us. Keep us from sinning when we are tempted. Save us from the evil one.' [For yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.] (Matthew 6:9-13)

Heart of the Lesson: Our Heavenly Father is the best dad (Matthew 6:31-33, Matthew 7:9-11, Matthew 6:7-8, Isaiah 6:1-5, & Ezekiel 39:7)
